






Food



- Arrive in Lyon 20.00



ACL Task (UK and US)

You will be asked to choose a work of art that strikes you as having a connection with a text on your literature programme.

You will be writing a response which analyses and interprets the artwork and then explores the connections with the literary text.

H/G Task (UK and US)

You will be creating a 'picture essay' that explores one particular dimension of London (e.g. wealth inequality, gentrification, globalisation, digitalisation, sustainability).

You will be taking 3-5 photographs to use and there will be an accompanying piece of writing to go with it.
